

Interested Arizona 6th grade Students

Camp Colton is an environmental education camp for sixth graders located 15 miles north of Flagstaff on 40 acres of private land surrounded by the Coconino National Forest.



Camp Colton has been part of the FUSD curriculum for all 6th graders in Flagstaff for over 30 years. In 2001 we obtained the status of a 501c3 non-profit organization and we now have the wonderful opportunity to expand our camp attendees to include 6th graders who are not a part of the Flagstaff Unified School District. We are excited about the possibilities this will provide, as we are now able to reach out to other Arizona schools and offer this wonderful educational program to them.

Camp Colton is a comfortable facility with a large central lodge, two bathroom/shower buildings for boys and girls. The students sleep in canvas tents with wooden floors and frames. The camp has many recreational opportunities for the students as well, including volleyball, tetherball and other games.

We are looking for groups outside FUSD to attend camp during our spring and fall sessions. Schools outside the FUSD that are interested in participating in our weeklong camp will be charged a fee of \$300 per student. This fee covers the cost of all their meals, supplies and 24-hour supervision by our trained staff. All transportation must be provided by the schools to and from the camp.
